Join Vikki for the reading of the classic book "Stellaluna," the story of a bat that thinks she is a bird. Then follow the reading with a fun hands-on activity!

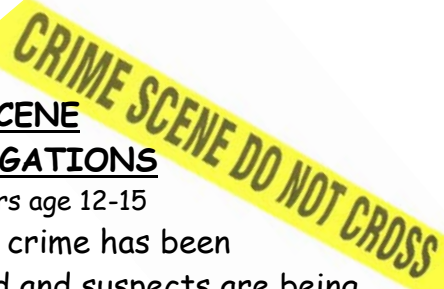


July 13:
