Conservation Fair and Earth Day Celebration

The Hi-Desert Nature Museum will hold its Annual Conservation Day and Earth Day Celebration on Saturday, April 18 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Yucca Valley Community Center Complex. The Earth Day Celebration features conservation groups, landscaping information, demonstrations, local artists, vendors, live performances, and international music.

Earth Day 2009 – Rules and Regulations

1. Vendor registration is open to non-profit organizations, for-profit companies, and local artists that have conservation or nature related products or services to sell or promote.
2. Vendor and exhibitor booths and spaces will be assigned on FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis.
3. Festival will be held rain or shine.
4. Vendors are required to supply a copy of a valid seller's permit. Applications for a "temporary seller's permit" can be requested from the State Board of Equalization at either of these offices: 3737 Main Street, Suite 1000, Riverside, CA 92501, (951)680-6400 or 42-700 Bob Hope Drive, Suite 301, Rancho Mirage, CA 92270, (760)770-4828.
5. The Town will supply one 8-foot table and two chairs per booth. Canopies or umbrellas are the responsibility of the vendor or exhibitor.
6. Each vendor and exhibitor is responsible for his/her booth and all items in it.
7. Booth must be ready to open by 9:00 a.m. and remain open until 2:00 p.m.
8. Food items and beverages are not to be sold or given away by a non-food vendor.
9. Food vendors must arrange for their own insurance and permit with the Department of Environmental Health Services (DEHS). For more information please call either one of these two numbers; Yucca Valley: 228-5410 or Victorville: 243-8141.
10. Vendor recycling is expected and containers will be provided.
11. Smoking is not permitted in vendor booths.
